- B. 2010 Protocol Changes:

- D. The end of the year is here..... Mason County policy requires you to have **6** base station meetings per year maintain your protocols. If you are using O<sup>T</sup>E<sup>P</sup> to recertify, you must have 24 sessions total during the recertification period or approx. 8 per year.
1. Those can be live or by video
  2. Some of you are behind for the year so you need to catch up by the end of December
- E. Currently there is reciprocity for Kitsap County for base station.
1. Starting the first of the year this reciprocity will be taken away.

2. You will be able to attend base station or watch a DVD which will not only satisfy your base station requirements but your OTEP credits.

- F. **Recertification:** January is Mason County's next recert months for District 6- 18 and MCMO.
1. IV technicians and paramedics must have had 8 OTEP sessions per year, or 24 OTEP for the 3 year recert period, if you are going by the OTEP method.
